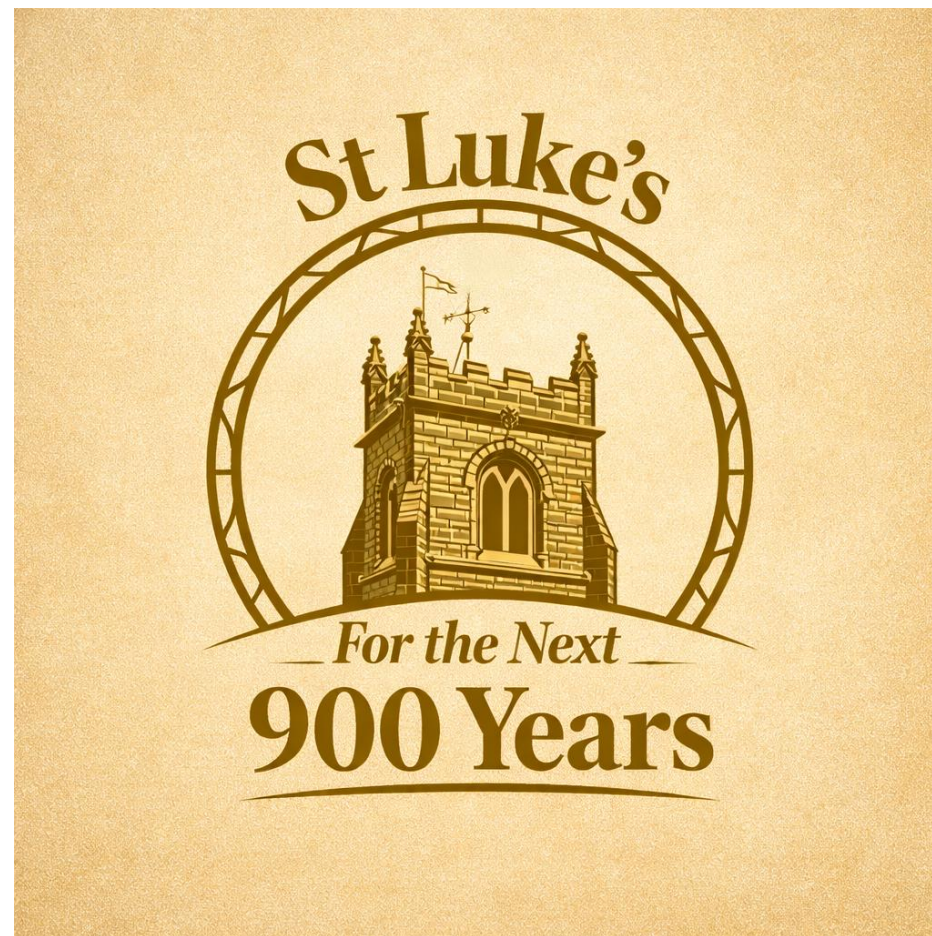

Supporting St Luke's Church for future generations



A message to friends, neighbours and the wider
Cannock community

St Luke's Church has stood at the heart of Cannock for more than 900 years. It has been a place of worship, celebration, comfort and support, and remains one of the town's most important historic landmarks giving the town its character and its identity.

Today, we must speak openly about the financial pressures we face and ask the wider community to help secure St Luke's future. For generations, the congregation has carried the responsibility of maintaining the church building. But rising costs, higher utility bills and the growing expense of repairs now make this increasingly difficult.



Maintaining a 900-year-old building places constant pressure on limited resources. Essential repairs over the past few years have reduced reserves, leaving little available for further urgent work needed to keep the church safe, secure and weatherproof for generations. To come.

There is no central Church of England fund to meet these costs; the money must be raised locally.

The Parochial Church Council is already reviewing spending, applying for grants, increasing community use of the facilities, organising fundraising events and encouraging regular giving. Even so, the present congregation can no longer carry this responsibility alone. Without wider support, there is a real risk that one day St. Luke's will have to close its doors.

We cannot allow that to happen!

Final Reflection



Imagine Cannock without St Luke's: no familiar tower, no bells across the town, no place for worship, remembrance, comfort or shared community memory. Imagine future generations learning that a church which survived

Norman England, the Reformation, Civil War, two World Wars and almost a millennium of history was lost — not through disaster, but because too few people helped when help was needed most.

For 900 years, ordinary people have protected St Luke's because they believed some things are bigger than ourselves. Its future now depends on this generation choosing to care for it.
